THE SHEEP

The trail begins at the


Sheep Gate. This was a small gate in the wall of Jerusalem. Through this Jesus entered on the Sunday now referred to as Palm Sunday, one week before Easter itself. He came riding on a donkey and was welcomed by a crowd who waved palm branches. Our Sheep Gate has been constructed by Glassford Evangelical Church and is in the lane just off Hills Road. Guided tours leave from here daily.




From the Upper Room cross Green Street and enter the Allison Green from Waterside Street. Here Avendale Church have constructed the Olive Grove where Jesus went to pray and the place where he was arrested on the night that he was betrayed by Judas.



From the Allis on Green now make your way to Thomson Street and the entrance to the former West Kirk halls. Here is the hidden entrance to the High Priests Courtyard. This was the place Jesus was first brought and the place where when he was challenged, Peter the disciple denied that he even knew Jesus.



lane along to the edge of the New Cemetery. Here we have a view over the town. As Jesus approached Jerusalem he stopped on a rise and wept for its people. Avendale Church have formed a view point here.

THE TEMPLE

Walk down the hill from the viewpoint and make your way to the Rankin Church on Lethame Rd. Here is represented 'The Temple'. This was the focal point of Jesus' teaching in this 'Holy Week'. But the authorities were hatching a plot to have him removed and bargained with Judas, the man who betrayed Jesus. They offered 30 pieces of silver for his life.



EROMAN FORT

From the courtyard head to Kirk Street and cross at the lights. Climb the stairs to Strathaven Castle. After his arrest the next place Jesus was taken was the Roman Fort where he was systematically beaten and tortured. Here at the Castle, the Outreach Community Church have constructed a scene to help reflection on the suffering of Jesus



GOLGOTHA THE HILL OF THE CROSS

Use the lights and cross back over the A71. Make your way up the monument hill. Here high above Strathaven the Outreach Community Church continue the scene of Christ's ultimate suffering at the Cross



THE TOMB

Finally, just below the crosses you will find the Tomb constructed by the East Kirk After his death, Jesus' body was taken to a tomb carved out of rock and a large and very heavy stone was rolled over the entrance.

Come again on Sunday at 8.30 a.m. to the Allison Green and celebrate the risen Saviour when we discover the surprise of the empty tomb!
